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## RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Council adopt Resolution No. 234-35 incorporating a list of projects for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be funded by SB 1: The Road Repair and Accountability Act.

## INTRODUCTION:

The City is required to adopt a resolution designating projects during Fiscal Year 2024-2025 which will be funded by SB 1: The Road Repair and Accountability Act.

## DISCUSSION:

Staff has prepared a list of projects to be competed for the FY 24-25, and this is a portion of that list to be completed utilizing the \$478,270.00 which the City is eligible to receive under Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (SB 1) for the FY 24-25. All projects funded by SB 1 will be completed in accordance to the recently adopted complete street policy.

The FY 24-25 list of projects planned to be funded with SB 1 revenues include:

**ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW (CEQA):**
