Good morning, Beorn – I am following up on the voice message I left you yesterday re: this project and the cultivation area verification (CAV) I performed.

I confirmed the applicant does have pre-existing mixed-light (approx. 6,925 sf) and outdoor (approx. 15,320) but the original application was for 7,829 sf mixed-light only under a Special Permit (SP). As a result, the request to add over 15K sf outdoor would require a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) and we cannot go up in case types after 12/31/2016 application deadline per the Hummap Settlement. However, I can issue an interim permit for approx. 3,075 sf of outdoor to the 6,925 sf outdoor for a total cultivation area of 10,000 sf, which is the max amount for a SP.
