DISCUSSION

The Pavement Rehabilitation 2022 Project entailed street rehabilitation on segments of 1st Street, 2nd Street, Dolbeer Street, Glen Street, M Street, Manzanita Avenue, S Street, Union Street, V Street, W Street (North), W Street (South), X Street, and Y Street. The project, which also included pedestrian improvements such as new bulb-outs, pedestrian activated rectangular rapid flashing beacons, curb ramps, crosswalks and thermoplastic markings, was awarded by Council on April 5, 2022, to Mercer-Fraser Company for the construction bid amount and contingency of \$3,500,000. This project was funded through Measure H and Gas Tax Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) funds.

The total construction amount for the project came to \$3,500,000.

Staff has determined that the work specified in the contract has been completed in substantial conformance with the plans and specifications. Therefore, staff recommends that Council accept the Pavement Rehabilitation 2022 Project and authorize staff to file a notice of completion for the project.
