### **DISCUSSION**

State law requires HCAOG to annually evaluate the unmet transit needs within its jurisdiction and prepare a report of its findings. As part of the process, entities receiving Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds may conduct separate hearings to gather input as to any unmet needs within the area. The information gathered at tonight's public hearing will be forwarded to HCAOG for consideration of these needs, if any, and for inclusion in the Unmet Needs Report of Findings for 2024-25.

Staff recommends holding a public hearing, accept comments and testimony regarding any unmet transit needs within the City of Eureka area, and at its conclusion direct staff to forward a transcript of comments to the Humboldt County Association of

Governments (HCAOG) for inclusion in the Unmet Needs Report of Findings for 2024-25.
