### **DISCUSSION**

The California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has issued a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA), dated March 29, 2023, for the Homekey Program. HCD has issued the NOFA for Homekey grant funds pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 50675.1.3 (Assem. Bill No. 140 (2021-2022 Reg. Sess.), § 20.).

HCD announced the availability of approximately \$736 million of Homekey Program grant funding through this Round 3 NOFA. Building on the success of both Project Roomkey and the first two rounds of Homekey, this significant investment continues a statewide effort to sustain and rapidly expand housing for persons experiencing homelessness or At Risk of Homelessness, and who are, thereby, disproportionately impacted by and at increased risk for medical diseases or conditions due to the COVID-19 pandemic or other communicable diseases.

The Department of Housing and Community Development is authorized to administer Homekey pursuant to the Multifamily Housing Program (Chapter 6.7 (commencing with Section 50675) of Part 2 of Division 31 of the Health and Safety Code). Homekey funding

allocations are subject to the terms and conditions of the NOFA, the Application, the Department-approved STD 213, Standard Agreement, and all other legal requirements of the Homekey Program.
