
RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF EUREKA TO ACCEPT THE TRANSFER OF RIGHT-OF-WAY ON FIFTH
STREET BETWEEN MYRTLE AVENUE AND R STREET FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CALTRANS)

- WHEREAS, a portion of Fifth Street is part of the right of way currently owned and maintained by Caltrans; and
- WHEREAS, a portion of R Street will be relocated and reconstructed by Caltrans; and
- WHEREAS, a portion of Myrtle Avenue will be relocated and reconstructed by Caltrans; and
- WHEREAS, Caltrans has prepared a map, attached as Exhibit "A" that shows the areas proposed to be relinquished to the City of Eureka; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Eureka, upon completion of the proposed relinquishment, assume control over and maintenance of the areas delineated in Exhibit "A", as they will become part of the City of Eureka street network.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Eureka, to agree, upon completion of the relinquishment process and following completion and acceptance of State of California Department of Transportation Contract 330454, to accept and assume, control and maintenance of the areas delineated on Exhibit "A".




