**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA APPROVING
PERSONNEL CHANGES TO THE EUREKA POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS There is a need to reorganize the Eureka Police Department to keep up with operational demands; and,

WHEREAS Recent turnover in professional staff positions have presented an opportunity to review and amend EPDs support-staff structure to better meet evolving administrative needs; and,

WHEREAS The addition of additional support staff to key functions in the department, as well as the creation of an advanced level support in the areas of evidence handling and crime analytics will improve operational effectiveness and streamline workflow; and,

WHEREAS The cost to implement the recommended changes will be covered by the salary savings from the unfilled Assistant Police Chief position, which will remain unfilled for the foreseeable future.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Eureka, to allocate one full-time Administrative Technician - (CONF) position and one regular part time Communications Dispatcher position to the Eureka Police Department in addition to approving the creation of a new Forensic Analyst I/II classification and reclassifying a current employee into the new position.
