**4.** Describe how the scope of your proposal fits the intent of *Measure Z*. Specifically, how will it maintain and improve public safety and essential services, as described on the previous page?

The City of Trinidad contracts with the Sheriff's Office for law enforcement. Since the Sheriff's Office has been short on staffing, the existing contract calls for patrols throughout the day. The City would like to provide staffing on the ground in addition to the patrols and therefore proposes the following options:

- 1. Contract with Pacific Coast Security out of Eureka to provide private security officers on the ground to supplement the Sheriff's Office patrols.
- 2. Create a Community Ambassadors Program similar to the City of Arcata's model where the ambassadors can interact with the community, homeless and visitors.

5. Please provide a brief description of the proposal for which you are seeking funding.

To supplement our Sheriff's Contract, we propose:

- a. Pacific Coast Security to provide private security officers on the ground in Trinidad to address law enforcement needs for residents, businesses and visitors. They will reach out to the Deputy Sheriffs as needed. We are budgeting 20 hours per week at \$45 per hour for one officer.
- b. Community Ambassadors Program to build relationships with the homeless, visitors, residents and businesses of our City. They will reach out to law enforcement if needed, and keep the city clean as they roam in business and recreational areas of the City. We are budgeting 20 hours per week at \$20 per hour for two ambassadors.
- c. In the event that the Sheriff's Office is able to provide a dedicated Deputy to Trinidad, the City would like to reserve the option to use some of these funds for that purpose.
- **6.** How have you developed a plan for sustainability, including diversification of funding sources, for your proposal to carry on without reliance on future *Measure Z* funds?

The City makes fiscally sound budgetary decisions in allocating general fund revenue, including public safety expenditures. We are increasing our transient occupancy tax rate and will reach out to the voters to extend our sales tax measure which includes funds for public safety.

7. If this request is for the continuation or expansion of an existing program/service, what is the current source of funding for that program/service?

We previously had one and a half Deputy Sheriffs dedicated to the City. In recent years the City has been served by Sheriff's Office patrols. This proposal is to expand our law enforcement services to include private security officers and community ambassadors. The City relies on general fund revenue and the State COPS program to fund law enforcement services.


The City has a grants administrator who continues to pursue grant funding. Community service organizations have consistently supported our public safety efforts. The private security officers and community ambassadors could enhance the City's relationship with the Trinidad Elementary School.
