Hi Megan,

The CAV is consistent with the quick measurements that I made based on the 2015 imagery. Thank you for the revision. Attached is an NOV and LSA non-compliance letter issued to the applicant on May 23, 2023. Ideally the applicant would address these violations and obtain good standing prior to cultivating. In terms of the restocking requirement for conifer, I concur that it seems odd to restock with conifer when there is conifer encroachment concerns in the oak woodland forest. CDFW would prefer additional conifer removal if allowed instead of the requirement to replant conifers. I recognize this requirement may be part of the ordinance, and may be automatically required, but we wanted to provide that feedback. CDFW is concerned that the applicant may not address the non-compliance and violations and request come condition to ensure the violations and non-compliance are addressed to achieve or maintain good standing with Humboldt County. I appreciate the opportunity to comment on this project.
