I hereby certify that this project will adhere to the following:

- a. Every effort will be made to use reuse and or recycling measures to reduce the amount of construction waste and other materials sent to landfill. Whenever possible, site-sorted debris boxes shall be used to segregate construction waste materials to maximize materials diversion.
- b. All personnel that will be performing any work on the project site will receive and read a copy of the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Plan (CDWMP). The CDWMP will meet all CALGreen requirements. Additionally, all personnel shall be instructed on the location and proper use of debris boxes for disposal of C&D materials.
- c. The process of waste management, recycling and reuse of construction waste materials will be monitored regularly to ensure compliance with the CDWMP during the course of the project.
- d. A record will be kept of the total amount of construction waste leaving the project site by weight or by volume, and how these materials will be disposed. This includes copies of tickets or detailed receipts from all loads of C&D materials removed from the project site.
- e. All supporting documentation which demonstrates compliance with the CDWMP and required diversion will be provided to the permitting jurisdiction upon completion of the project.
