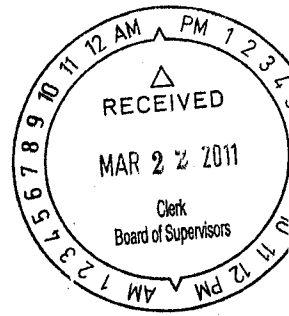



For the last 23 years, Mr. Bacik's law practice has emphasized natural resource management, land-use planning, real estate development, environmental impact review, and related regulatory, administrative and government agency permitting issues.

In private practice for nearly twenty years with offices in Ukiah and Eureka, he has represented and counseled clients in a wide range of successful land-use projects, both in planning and implementation stages, as well as through administrative, trial, and appellate litigation in the California State and federal courts.

From 2006 through July, 2008, Frank served as the Vice President and General Counsel for The Pacific Lumber Company (PALCO) and several affiliated timberland management, natural resources and forest products companies, all located in Humboldt County.
