## RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors receive and file this report, provide staff with direction as necessary, and direct staff to prepare for a public hearing at a specified date on the recommended supervisorial district lines.

# SOURCE OF FUNDING:

General Fund.

## **DISCUSSION:**

Supervisorial Districts are based on population and State and Federal law require that boundaries of these districts be adjusted after each federal census. The process must be completed by November 1, of the year following the census. The 2010 Census data show significant growth in the Second and Fifth Supervisorial Districts. As shown in attachment A, Humboldt County population for the year 2010 totals 134,623. The ideal population for each supervisorial district is 26,925 ( $\pm$  2.5%). The data show the Second Supervisorial District with the highest population of

29,503, 9.57% higher than the ideal population. The First Supervisorial District has the lowest population of 25,231, -6.29% lower than the ideal population. In order to achieve the ideal population in each district, precincts from the Second and Fifth Supervisorial Districts would need to be moved in order to increase the totals for the First, Third and Fourth Supervisorial Districts.

The legal requirements concerning supervisorial boundaries are set forth in the Elections Code.

**Section 21500** Following each decennial federal census, and using that census as a basis, the board shall adjust the boundaries of any or all of the supervisorial districts of the county so that the districts shall be as nearly equal in population as may be and shall comply with the applicable provisions of Section 1973 of Title 42 of the United States Code [Voting Rights Act], as amended. In establishing the boundaries of the districts the board may give consideration to the following factors: (a) topography, (b) geography, (c) cohesiveness, contiguity, integrity, and compactness of territory, and (d) community of interests of the districts.

**Section 21500.1** The board shall hold at least one public hearing on any proposal to adjust the boundaries of a district, prior to a public hearing at which the board votes to approve or defeat the proposal.

## FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Staff time in creating official boundaries and maps, reproduction of maps, and notification to voters impacted by boundary changes.

## OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The Community Development Department has been assisting Elections staff with Census information displayed in the county's GIS program.

## **ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:**
