Subject: Urgency Ordinance to Address Health & Safety Issues at the Humboldt County Courthouse

RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors, by a 4/5 vote:

1. Introduce by title Ordinance No. ____ (Attachment 1), regarding health and safety issues at the Humboldt County Courthouse, waive the first reading of the ordinance and adopt the ordinance as an urgency ordinance pursuant to Government Code Section 25123(d); and
2. Direct the Clerk of the Board, within 15 days, to publish a post-adoption summary of the ordinance (Attachment 2) with the names of the Supervisors voting for and against the ordinance, and to post in the office of the Clerk of the Board a certified copy of the full text of the adopted ordinance and amendments along with the names of those Supervisors voting for and against the ordinance [Government Code Section 25124(b)(1)].

the City of Eureka, Law Enforcement, Human Rights Commission, the current Occupiers as well as other historic users of County Property to craft language for an ordinance regulating the uses of County Properties, and return to the Board for a public hearing and consideration.”

On March 20, the Board received an update on the progress of that work and an update on the current conditions on the Courthouse grounds. As was discussed on the 20th, there are growing citizen complaints about conditions on the grounds, including public urination, defecation, indecent exposure, assaults and continued overnight camping with its associated problems. As a result of this update and mounting concerns of deteriorating health and safety conditions associated with inappropriate uses of the Courthouse grounds, the Board directed staff to return with an urgency ordinance to alleviate these health and safety issues at the Courthouse. Staff’s draft of such an ordinance is attached.

The Courthouse grounds are a resource for everyone and should be available to all members of the public, including employees, in a safe and sanitary condition. When the grounds are used for camping, storing property and other incompatible activities it interferes with the rights of the public to use the grounds for the purposes for which they were intended, inhibits access to public buildings and subjects the public to health and safety risks. The County has the duty to maintain the Courthouse grounds open to the public in a safe, sanitary and accessible condition.

The proposed urgency ordinance is designed to address these health, safety and access concerns by prohibiting the following activities which are incompatible with the County’s duty to keep the Courthouse grounds open to the public in a safe, sanitary and accessible condition:

- Camping on the Courthouse grounds.
- Storing personal property.
- Erecting structures or securing items to County property.
- Obstructing access or interfering with the passage of others.
- Using the Courthouse grounds between 9:30 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- Littering on, damaging or defacing County property.
- Letting loose non-service animals.
- Using or interfering with County water and electrical services.
- Urinating or defecating on the Courthouse grounds.
- Operating a food facility.

The proposed ordinance prohibits these activities to protect the health and safety of all users of the Courthouse facility.

In order to enact the proposed ordinance as an urgency measure, the Board is required to make findings regarding the necessity of so doing. Draft findings are contained in Section 1 of the proposed ordinance. These are supported by the discussion and testimony received on the proposed ordinance and the materials contained in Attachment 3, which are written complaints collected by the County’s Risk Management staff.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The only costs associated with passage of the proposed ordinance are the minimal costs for required publication of the ordinance. These costs can be absorbed within the existing budget for the Clerk of the Board. Depending on decisions made by individuals in response to an ordinance, there could be costs associated with enforcement and/or legal defense of the ordinance.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT: City of Eureka

ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. The Board could choose not to adopt the proposed ordinance and direct staff to refocus on the ordinance as directed on January 17.
2. The Board could choose to adopt the ordinance as a regular ordinance rather than an urgency ordinance. This would require a second reading of the ordinance and the ordinance would not be effective for 30 days.

**AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
COUNTY OF HUMBOLDT ADDING CHAPTER 2.5 RELATING TO REGULATION
OF THE GROUNDS OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY COURTHOUSE TO DIVISION 6
OF TITLE II OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY CODE**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Humboldt ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Legislative Findings:

The County of Humboldt may make and enforce within its limits all local, police, sanitary, and other ordinances and regulations not in conflict with general laws pursuant to Article XI, Section 7 of the California Constitution. Under Section 23004 of the Government Code, the County has the authority to manage its property. In addition to this authority, the County also has the duty to keep its property open and available for the purposes to which it is dedicated.

Pursuant to Section 25123(d) of the Government Code, this urgency ordinance is required for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety as described herein.

The County is concerned about mounting problems related to inappropriate uses of the County Courthouse grounds ("grounds"), including camping, storage of personal property, public urination and defecation and other health and safety issues.

Camping and/or storage of personal property on the grounds has led to a buildup of litter and waste. The County has insufficient resources to keep pace with waste removal and the buildup of waste on the grounds has negatively affected the public health and welfare. Also, food preparation and service are taking place on the grounds in unsanitary conditions.

Nighttime activities on the grounds have led to public disturbances, overnight accumulation of waste, damage to the grounds and other public health and safety problems.

Camping, storage of personal property and nighttime activities on the grounds directly adjacent to the County Courthouse and the Humboldt County Correctional Facility is fundamentally incompatible with the security of those facilities.

The County has historically received a minimal number of complaints related to the grounds. However, since January of 2012, the County has experienced an exponential increase in complaints related to incidents on the grounds. These incidents include numerous complaints of public urination and defecation, threatening and abusive language, sexual harassment and smoking of marijuana.

From January 13, 2012 to March 15, 2012 the Eureka Police Department received 139 calls for service relating to incidents on the grounds. Among these incidents were calls for service involving assaults and public drunkenness. Also during this period there were 26 arrests and 2 medical calls for assistance on the grounds.

These activities and complaints represent a significant increase in activities with a direct negative impact on the public peace, health and safety. The County seeks to ensure that the grounds are used in a manner consistent with promoting the health, safety, and welfare of all of its residents.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Humboldt finds that this urgency ordinance is necessary to maintain the County Courthouse grounds open to the public in a safe, sanitary and accessible condition for all the reasons stated herein.

SECTION 2. Chapter 2.5 of Division 6 of Title II of the Humboldt County Code is hereby added as shown on the attached pages.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any provision of this chapter or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this chapter which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this section are severable.

SECTION 4. Exemption From CEQA. The Board of Supervisors finds, pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations, Section 15061(b)(3), that this ordinance is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in that it is not a "project" which has the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This ordinance is an ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by a four-fifths (4/5) vote of the Board of Supervisors in accordance with Section 25123(d) of the Government Code of the State of California. The facts constituting the emergency are contained in Section 1 of this ordinance and the board report thereto.

CHAPTER 2.5

REGULATION OF THE GROUNDS OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY COURTHOUSE262.5-1. PURPOSE.

The public areas of the County Courthouse grounds should be readily accessible and available to residents and the public at large in a safe and sanitary condition. The use of the grounds for camping, storage of personal property, or public urination and defecation interferes with the rights of others to use the grounds for the purposes for which they were intended, and subjects the public to substantial health and safety risks. The purpose of this chapter is to maintain the County Courthouse grounds open to the public in a safe, sanitary and accessible condition. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)

262.5-2. DEFINITIONS.

Unless the particular provisions or the context otherwise requires, the definitions contained in this section shall govern the construction, meaning and application of words and phrases used in this chapter. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)

(a) "Camp" means one or more of the following activities: pitching or occupying camp facilities; the use of camp paraphernalia; to make or kindle a fire for any purpose. These activities constitute camping when it reasonably appears, in light of all the circumstances, that the individual, in conducting these activities, is in fact using the area as a living accommodation regardless of the intent of the individual or the nature of any other activities in which they may be engaging. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)

(b) "Camp facilities" include, but are not limited to, tents, huts, temporary shelters, or other similar facilities. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)

(c) "Camp paraphernalia" includes, but is not limited to, tarpaulins, cots, beds, mattresses, sleeping bags, hammocks, cookware, cooking equipment, kitchen utensils or other similar equipment. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)

(d) "County Courthouse grounds" or "grounds" are defined as the public areas outside of the County Courthouse and Humboldt County Correctional Facility located in the City of Eureka, County of Humboldt, State of California, bounded by "K" Street on the east, Fourth Street on the north, "I" Street on the west, and Fifth Street on the south and the County parking lot on the south side of Fifth Street between "I" Street and "J" Street. Grounds include all parking lots, walkways, lawns, planters, steps, stairs, breezeways and any other area outside of the buildings located thereon. This chapter shall not apply to the public sidewalks directly bordering the grounds. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)

(e) "Store" means to put aside or accumulate for use when needed, to put for safekeeping, or to place or leave in a location. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)

(f) "Waste matter" means any discarded, used, or leftover substance including, but not limited to, a lighted or nonlighted cigarette, cigar, match, or any flaming or glowing material, or any garbage, trash, refuse, paper, container, packaging or construction material, carcass of a dead animal, any nauseous or offensive matter of any kind, or any object likely to injure any person. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)

262.5-3. PROHIBITED ACTS.

It is unlawful for any person to do any of the acts hereinafter enumerated on the County Courthouse grounds: (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)

- (a) To camp on the County Courthouse grounds. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)
- (b) To store personal property, including camp facilities and camp paraphernalia, construction materials, tools, lumber, paint, tarps, tables, luggage, or clothing and all other similar property. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)
- (c) To construct or erect any building or structure of any kind, whether permanent or temporary in character, including but not limited to any tent, awning, windbreak or similar structure. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)
- (d) To secure any object, including but not limited to, clothing, bedding or signs to County property in any way or run or string any rope, cord, ribbon, twine, wire or similar item into, upon, or across County Courthouse grounds. For purposes of this section, to secure includes use of any weighted or self-stabilized object. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)
- (e) To be on the County Courthouse grounds for any other purpose other than those listed below between the hours of nine thirty p.m. and six a.m. of the next succeeding day. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)
- (1) County and Court employees or contactors on the grounds for duty purposes. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)
 - (2) Law enforcement, medical or fire personnel on the grounds for duty purposes. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)
 - (3) Members of the public contacting the Sheriff's office or attending public meetings in accordance with Chapter 2 of this division. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)
 - (4) Persons proceeding directly to or from a vehicle in the parking lot east of the Humboldt County Correctional Facility and immediately thereafter leaving the grounds. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)
 - (5) Persons proceeding immediately off the grounds after release from the Humboldt County Correctional Facility. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)
- (f) To throw or place waste matter of any kind whatsoever, or any other article or thing, upon the County Courthouse grounds unless in a properly designated receptacle. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)
- (g) To damage or cause to be damaged any of the vegetation, grass, trees, shrubbery, flowers, buildings or other property on the County Courthouse grounds in any manner, including securing or anchoring any object into the earth. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)
- (h) To write, print, cut or carve or otherwise mark in or upon any building or buildings or any seats or benches or any other property whatsoever on the County Courthouse grounds, or any other property whatsoever belonging to the County. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)
- (i) To lead or let loose any animal other than dogs on a leash not more than six feet long. This section shall not apply to service animals, as defined in the Americans with Disabilities Act. (Ord. ____, § __, __/__/2012)

(j) To open, use, expose, deface or interfere with any water pipe, hydrant, spigot, sprinkler, camera, light, electrical outlet, sign or other installation on County Courthouse grounds. (Ord. _____, § __, __/__/2012)

(k) To take up any portion of the County Courthouse grounds so as to obstruct or interfere with the flow of pedestrians, whether such person does so alone or together with one or more persons, or with equipment or personal property of any nature, and whether such person does so by standing, sitting, lying, or in any other manner. (Ord. _____, § __, __/__/2012)

(l) To urinate or defecate on County Courthouse grounds. (Ord. _____, § __, __/__/2012)

(m) To operate a food facility as defined in the Section 113789 of the California Health and Safety Code, or any successor statute thereto, including mobile and temporary facilities. (Ord. _____, § __, __/__/2012)

262.5-4. PENALTY.

Any person who fails to comply with any provision of this chapter is deemed guilty of a misdemeanor. Each day during any portion of which any violation of this chapter is committed, continued or permitted is deemed a separate offense. (Ord. _____, § __, __/__/2012)

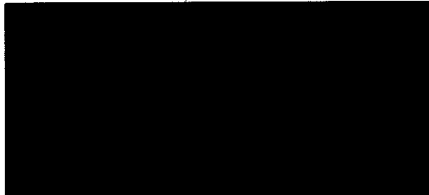

Fifth Street Security called me about occupy protestor, "████" who was sitting on the top landing playing the guitar and singing. I responded to station and was informed they had received approximately 50 complaints due to offensive language by the occupier/singer. It was reported that █████ was singing using the words "kill whitey" and had made the statement to a handicapped woman she was a "cripple bitch". No complainant's names had been taken at this time.

I went outside and spoke with █████. I informed him that security had received approximately 50 complaints about his language. He stated that was impossible. I asked him if he had made a statement to a handicapped woman, which he denied. I asked him about the words he was singing at which time he began singing "kill whitey". I informed him that using the term "kill" was inappropriate and crossing a line. I then asked him to stop using the term. He then changed the word "kill" in his song to "kick".

Upon returning to the courthouse, I requested that security take name, date, time, phone number, and a brief statement from anyone who had a complaint.

While observing EPD removing "Occupy Protestors" non-allowed items from in front of the courthouse, a white adult male app. mid twenties accused me of calling the police and began to make rude comments and offensive gestures towards me. He gave me the finger and said I was an F***ing narc. He was clearly agitated and continued with the gestures and language which I ignored. [REDACTED] from security witnessed the language and gestures. [REDACTED] came to me on the top landing and asked if he was yelling at me. There was no one around me the entire time the young man was yelling.

After [REDACTED] went below the stairs to check the perimeter, the young man continued the verbal accusations and made the statement, "I will bring this whole F***ing building down". At that time I warned him to be careful about what he said. [REDACTED] did not witness the protestor making the statement. I will attempt to get a photograph of this individual for this report. There should be video of the individual making gestures.

Also there were 3 locations where I saw evidence of someone having a bowel movement (BM). There was a BM in the parking space of the health officer, soiled toilet paper was under the trees at J and 6th. And there was a BM and soiled toilet paper in the bushes directly across from the Courthouse on the PHB side of the street.

As you may be aware since this past March, I have been working nearly every day gardening on our block. I try to pick up trash before work everyday. These past 2 weeks I have seen a huge jump in BMs and folks sleeping on our block. I am especially concerned as we see patients from babies to seniors giving them immunizations daily.

Re: Late Night Experience with Occupation Protestors on January 12, 2012

I was asked by my supervisor to document and send to you both a description of what I witnessed after the Planning Commission meeting on Thursday, January 12, 2012 at about 9:35 p.m..

At the end of the meeting, [REDACTED], the security guard, pulled me aside and asked me to go look at something out the 5th Street doors with him. There, he pointed out a pick-up truck that was parked in the paved employee parking lot nearest to the intersection of I and 5th. There were perhaps 8-12 people ringed around the vehicle's open doors and truck bed. I could hear loud music and people yelling and laughing. It looked and sounded like a party. [REDACTED] told that me that this was a re-supply truck for the Occupy protesters at the Courthouse and that the Sheriff's Office Civil Division had been trying to serve the driver of the truck and he wanted to know what he should do to notify him of the truck's location. We talked about that for a few minutes and then I went back to my office to put my Planning Commission documents away and get my coat and my purse.

When I came back out of my office, Planner [REDACTED] was also on her way out and we walked out the 5th street doors together. She told me that she had driven her family's old truck and that it was parked on the south-side curb of 5th street. As I was parked in the paved employee parking lot closest to the intersection of J and 5th, I walked with her. When we got to the southern sidewalk, we could see that someone had smashed the passenger-side window on her truck. The center part of the window was broken through and the rest of the window appeared to be precariously attached shattered glass. We looked around but didn't see any sign of what broke the window. She borrowed my cell phone to call 911 and I walked over to my car to see if it had been broken into, as well. As I was walking to my car I heard some noises near one of the shrubs dividing the employee parking lot. I looked over and saw a man in his early 20s or late teens urinating into the shrub. I continued walking to my car and then walked around it to see if any windows were busted out. As I went around my car to confirm there was no damage, I heard

talking and laughing and looked towards the parking area near the Public Health building. There were two people sitting on one of the curbs near another bush, smoking what smelled like marijuana and passing what looked to be a slim pipe or a thick joint back and forth.

I returned to [REDACTED] and she told me that the 911 dispatcher told her that apparently a correctional officer had seen a person breaking her window and had called the Eureka Police Department (EPD), but that no one had been apprehended. She gave an EPD case number for Beth to pass on to her insurance company.

While we were standing there discussing the situation and trying to clean glass out of her car, I saw probably 6-7 people wrapped in blankets who appeared in their late teens/early 20s walk fairly slowly across 5th street to and from the pick-up truck in the employee parking lot. They weren't in the crosswalk and didn't appear to be walking with the signal lights. I saw a couple of cars have to stop fairly quickly to avoid hitting them as they journeyed back and fourth between the occupy Eureka table at the courthouse and the party at the truck at the employee parking lot. They didn't seem to be ferrying supplies or anything similar. They appeared to be crossing the street in primarily to obstruct traffic.

While I was watching this going on, a modified and lowered sports car drove up to the courthouse side of 5th street playing very loud music. They stopped, opened the driver's side door so the music was louder and then the passenger emerged from the car carrying a bunch of glow sticks. He went to the Occupy table by the courthouse and started to dance in that area with the glow sticks. By this time, [REDACTED] had removed enough glass to get into the truck and drive home. I went to my car and drove home as well.

What I saw during the 15-20 minutes outlined above had a menacing overtone. I am not someone who is afraid to walk around the courthouse or any part of Old Town Eureka at night. I frequently have to park several blocks away from the courthouse on nights that the Planning Commission is in session and I have never been worried about my safety in walking to my car at 10 p.m. But the conduct of the people that I observed made me nervous because it was clear that they had no interest in protesting anything, obeying any laws, or even exhibiting any common courtesy. They were just concerned with their own pleasures/interests in maintaining their afterhours Courthouse party and creating as much chaos as they could. As strange as it may sound, it felt like I was watching *Lord of Flies* in the making.

I am not altogether comfortable in documenting this as I can consider myself a pretty confident person regarding my physical safety. I am still a bit shaken up by the atmosphere I saw and experienced that night and by the fact that it was the first time I've felt unsafe being in the vicinity of the Courthouse late at night. In all honesty, I would not have documented this without my supervisor's repeated request that I report my observations and feelings about what I saw to the Risk Manager.

FYI -

This morning at approx 0855 hrs Eureka Police officers responded to 3501 O Street on a report that unknown subjects were inside a vacant house without permission. Upon arrival officers quickly learned that the vacant house was indeed occupied by several individuals and that the subjects had barricaded themselves inside. Upon making verbal contact with the subjects, the subjects freely admitted that they were affiliated with Occupy Eureka and that police officers had no legal reason to remove them from the house. Persons responsible for the house were also on scene and advised the officers that the subjects did not have permission to be in the house.

Continuous verbal orders to voluntarily exit the house were only accepted by two of the individual (approximately 30 minutes after officers arrived on scene). The two subjects were identified as;

Officers attempted to gain entry into the house at several entry points but were initially unsuccessful. After being on scene for approximately 55 minutes the officers were able to force the front door, overcoming a wooden cross bar and the suspects' body weight. The suspects found in the house were identified as;

All six suspects were arrested and booked at the Jail for 602.5 / 148(a) / 594(b)(1) / 182 PC (trespass / resist/delay officer / vandalism / conspiracy).

It should be noted that the suspects had changed the locks, installed a wooden cross bar on the front door, and painted/wrote on the interior walls of the house.

A seventh suspect vacated the residence before officers arrived on scene. A photo of the seventh suspect was taken by a property management maintenance worker. Officers will be working to identify this subject.

In fact, we sent an officer and our mental health employee to talk to the folks to offer help and got no takers.

Just to keep everyone informed-----Last Friday (Feb. 3rd), between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. there was a group calling themselves, "Take back our Court House," that gathered at the Court House and co-mingled with the Occupiers. No serious problems, just one arrest of an occupier. However, during the two hours people with the Occupy group kept attaching signs to the county fence. As soon as officers would remove them, the occupiers would put them back. We finally placed two officers at the fence to prevent them from violating the law.

The next day they did an "in your face" thing and placed 24 signs on the fence. Officers removed them and warned all the people there they would be arrested if they persisted in breaking the law. One of these persons was [REDACTED] who the PD considers an agitator who enjoys trying to bait officers by getting in their faces verbally and with a camera. [REDACTED] had placed on his face book that day a film of the officers telling him not to place signs on the fence. That has been added to the evidence.

Today, officers shortly after noon removed several signs on the fence and again verbally warned people about doing this.
