A - To eliminate a cash deficit in Fund 241 (General CIP) related to the Sequoia Park Zoo Canopy Walk Project. \$600,000 of the the projected was funded through the Eureka Lodging Alliance (ELA). The ELA reimburses the City in the amount of \$60,000 every fiscal year, for ten years, and has provided two years of payments. The General Fund would received the annual payments in future years in the amount of \$480,000.

B - Remove the Building Fund subsidy due to the fiscal health of the Building Fund.

C - Remove transfers to Fund 240 (Street CIP) for reporting purposes.

D - Adjust transfers for Water & Wastewater capital projects to reflect actual expenditures in FY2022-23.
