DISCUSSION

The City of Eureka wastewater treatment plant includes two circular secondary clarifiers that were constructed approximately 35 year ago. The City yearly performed preventative maintenance on the main drive, cleaned and spot recoated steel components, but over the years of service the steel components have continued to degrade along with the degradation of the internal gearing. In 2019 while replacing the clarifier drive and bridge systems for both clarifiers it was found that the effluent troughs and supports were corroded and deteriorating rapidly. After a few years of patch welding it is necessary to install a new scum skimmer system.

This project was brought before Council on July 5, 2022 and awarded to O&M Industries for the construction bid amount of \$1,041,290.00 for construction. During the course of the project, two change orders were executed to account for changes in the work scope for a total of \$17,997.93, bringing the construction amount to \$1,059,287.93. An additional appropriation in the amount of \$17,997.93 is requested at this time to cover the additional construction cost.

Staff has determined that the work specified in the contract has been completed in substantial conformance with the Plans and Specifications. Therefore, staff recommends that Council accept this project, allocate additional funds in the amount of \$17,997.93 and authorize the filing of a "Notice of Completion" at the Office of the County Recorder.
