**RESOLUTION OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
ESTABLISHING THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR THE  
COUNTY OF HUMBOLDT**

**WHEREAS**, Article XIII B of the California Constitution, added by Proposition 4 (November 1979) and subsequently amended by Proposition 98 (November 1988) and Proposition 111 (June 1990) provides that the state and each local government shall establish an annual Appropriations Limit; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 8(e)(2) of Article XIII B of the California Constitution requires the Governing Body to select the Change in Cost of Living methodology each year by recorded vote of the governing body; and

**WHEREAS**, the percentage change in the California per capita income provides a higher change in Cost of Living index than the change in the local assessment roll from the preceding year due to the addition of local nonresidential new construction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Humboldt County Auditor-Controller's Office has prepared the calculation and made the same available for public review during business hours for fifteen (15) days prior to the October 3, 2023, Humboldt County Board of Supervisors meeting in compliance with California Government Code Section 7910(a); and

**WHEREAS**, the Humboldt County Clerk of the Board's Office published notice on or before September 17, 2023 of the location where the applicable statements were available for public inspection.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the County of Humboldt selects the percentage change in per-capita income and the percentage change in the population within the incorporated portion of Humboldt County; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the fiscal year 2023-2024 Appropriations Limit for the County of Humboldt as shown on Attachment A is hereby established as Two Hundred Forty-Five Million Two Hundred Thirty Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Seven Dollars (\$245,230,237.00) and that such Appropriations Limit may be adjusted at a later date in accordance with Sections 3 and 11 of Article XIII B of the California Constitution; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Appropriations Limit fiscal year 2023-2024 Appropriations Limit for the County of Humboldt may be adjusted at a later date in the event that revenues which are unanticipated and classified as proceeds of taxes in accordance with Section 8(c) of Article XIII B of the California Constitution, are received and appropriated.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that any judicial action or proceeding to attack, review, set aside, void or annul the fiscal year 2023-2024 Appropriations Limit for the County of Humboldt established by this resolution shall be commenced within forty-five (45) days from the date of

adoption of this resolution in accordance with Division 9 of Title 1 of the California Government Code.
