DISCUSSION

This project consisted, in general, of digging and replacing approximately 2,400 linear feet of 6" and 8" VCP pipe and replacing it with SDR35 polyvinyl chloride (PVC) pipe; Cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) lining of approximately 1,600 linear feet of 6" and 8" VCP pipe; rehabilitation of 11 manholes with a grout and epoxy coating; rehabilitation or replacement of 72 sewer laterals; and hot-mix asphalt paving. The locations of the project are M Street from 5th to 15th Streets, Summer Street from 14th to 15th Streets, and 15th Street from Summer to Union Streets.

This project was brought before Council on April 19, 2022, and was awarded to Mercer-Fraser Company for the construction bid amount of \$1,079,872 with an additional 15% contingency for a total of \$1,250,000. Additional repairs to manholes were made, a lift station wet well was sealed to stop infiltration of ground water, and laterals were removed from the project. In all, change orders increased the project total by \$150,876.15 for a new project total of \$1,230,748.15, still below the approved amount.

Staff has determined that the work specified in the contract has been completed in substantial conformance with the Plans and Specifications. Therefore, staff recommends that Council accept this project and authorize the filing of a "Notice of Completion" at the Office of the County Recorder.
