**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA APPROVING A
NEW CLASSIFICATION**

WHEREAS, In an effort to improve Code Enforcement functions within the Public Works Department the City has created the classification of Parking Enforcement Officer (full-time); and,

WHEREAS, The classification of Parking Enforcement Officer will work with the City's existing Code Enforcement teams, fostering collaboration and ensuring that Public Works operations run smoothly; and,

WHEREAS, The classification of Parking Enforcement Officer allows for upward mobility within the Public Works Department which can be positive for recruitment and retention; and,

WHEREAS, No additional allocated city funds are needed to adopt this new classification;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Eureka, that:
Adopts resolution adding new classification of Parking Enforcement Officer, to the City's Classification and Compensation Plan.
