Hi Rodney,

I reviewed the Strombeck ZR/PMS (PLN-2023-18708; APN 511-491-021) and would like to suggest a minor edit to the biologist's proposed recommendation for avoiding impacts to nesting birds. It's a little vague as written and could benefit from more specific language:

Vegetation removal should occur outside of nesting season (generally March 15 – August 15) to avoid impacts to native resident and migratory birds. If that's not feasible, a qualified biologist shall survey for active bird nests no more than seven days prior to tree removal or significant trimming. If an active nest is found, the permittee should consult with CDFW regarding appropriate site-specific avoidance measures and buffer distances. If there is a lapse in project-related activities of seven days or more, the biologist should re-survey the area before work resumes.

CDFW also recommends updating the parcel subdivision map to depict the SMA buffer around the unnamed tributary to Rose Creek and condition any future development to be sited outside that setback.

Following up on our phone call this afternoon, DEH has reviewed the provided water production testing and OWTS Suitability Report and have determined need for additional information regarding the OWTS Suitability Report before we can recommend approval:

- Resulting Developed Parcel (Parcel 1) additional soils testing required to establish a reserve dispersal field area.
- Resulting Vacant Parcel (Parcel 2) wet weather testing or alternative soils testing (plasticity index test) justifying dry weather testing required.

DEH staff communicated these deficiencies to the OWTS consultant (Andy Sundquist, PE; Candor Rock, Inc.) on 10/30/23. We have yet to receive amendments to the OWTS Suitability Report. I'll make a note in the project workflow, and we'll reach out to the OWTS consultant again to see if there's been any movement on their end. Please let me know if you have any additional questions.
