A General Municipal Election will be held November 5, 2024 for the election of City Council members residing in the second and fourth wards. At the October 17, 2023 meeting, Council received and filed the "Certificate of Sufficiency of Initiative Petition" and directed the City Clerk to submit the initiative without alteration to the voters at the next General Election to be held November 5, 2024.
