RESOLUTION NO. 2024-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA FINDING THAT SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT OF CERTAIN DOCK PILINGS IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CITY AND IN COMPLIANCE WITH ITS PROCUREMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, the Eureka Police Department's Body Worn Camera system is outdated and out of warranty needing to be replaced as soon as possible; and

WHEREAS, the requested purchase of 50 new MotorolaV700 Body Worn Cameras and all associated equipment storage will supply the department with a reliable system for the next five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the continuity of the current system and storage can only be accomplished by purchasing Motorola cameras with their unique storage and evidence library system; and

WHEREAS, this specific purchase through Motorola, formally Watch Guard, will allow our current storage and system of retrieving to remain the same and be built upon, as the only option for this continuity; and

WHEREAS, under the Eureka Municipal Code: "A purchase may be made or contract awarded without a competitive procurement process when there is only one reasonable and practicable source for the required goods or services because of the unique quality of the goods or services; availability; compatibility with existing city programs, equipment or systems; or fitness for a particular use."; and

WHERAS, the equipment in this case qualifies for sole sourcing because of the unique quality of the goods and services to meet compatibility with our current system; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Eureka hereby:

- 1. Declares that the above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated into this resolution as findings of the City Council.
- 2. Finds that City Council has considered the circumstances surrounding the proposed procurement of 50 new Motorola V700 Body Worn Cameras for the Eureka Police Department's camera upgrade and:
 - It is in the best interest of the City to purchase the cameras described herein from Motorola Solutions, pursuant to Eureka Municipal Code § 39.41(A); and

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- That the sole source purchase of the equipment is in accordance with the City's procurement policies and procedures.
- 3. Declares that as a result of the findings in provision 2 above, that the City is authorized to use sole source procurement for the purchase of 50 Motorola V700 Body Worn Cameras for the Eureka Police Department.
- 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this resolution is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, unlawful, or otherwise invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction or preempted by state legislation, such decision or legislation shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed and adopted this resolution and each and all provisions thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more of said provisions be declared unconstitutional, unlawful or otherwise invalid.
- 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
