**RECOMMENDATION**

1. Declare Mercer Fraser Company the low bidder for the Pavement Rehabilitation 2024 Project; and
2. Award Bid No. 2024-17 to Mercer Fraser Company for the amount of \$2,258,258; and
3. Approve \$2,500,000 for pavement rehabilitation items, which includes a contingency of approximately 9.6%.

**DISCUSSION**

The Pavement Rehabilitation 2024 Project will consist of street rehabilitation in Eureka on: Myrtle Avenue between 5<sup>th</sup> Street to Harrison Avenue, H Street between Harris and Oak Streets and Harris Street between Broadway and A Street. This project has been previously identified in the Capital Improvement Program.

Pursuant to the City's Complete Streets Resolution, the following multi-modal improvements are included in the project:

- Bicycle improvements on Myrtle Avenue, including extension of the bike facility, along with new striping, signage and related intersection improvements
- Buffered bike lanes on H Street from Harris to Oak Streets
- Buffered bike lanes on Harris Street from Broadway to A Street
- Pedestrian improvements, including truncated domes additions to sidewalks, as well as new thermoplastic markings throughout the entire project area

The project was advertised on August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, and bids were received on August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Five (5) bids were received, with Mercer Fraser Company being the low bidder, see bid summary below. Staff reviewed and evaluated the bids and determined the low bid to be in conformance with the project requirements.

Staff recommends that Council declare Mercer Fraser Company the low bidder on the Pavement Rehabilitation 2024 Project; award construction of Bid No. 2024-17 to Mercer Fraser Company for the amount of \$2,258,258 and approve \$2,500,000 for the project construction, including contingency.

Construction is expected to begin in the fall of 2024.
