RE: Notice Of Completed Work - LSAA 1600-2019-0673-R1

To Whom It May Concern,

This document shall serve as notice of completion of the above referenced Lake And Streambed Alteration Agreement for Tierra Verde Holdings LLC, located at 3897 North A Road, Garvberville, CA. 95542 (APN 218-021-003). All work was completed by the agreed upon date (via a one year extension) of October 15, 2024. The completed work was as follows:

Crossing #1: Replaced the undersized 30” diameter culvert with a 48” diameter culvert, with the length extending past the fill prism of the road. This was undertaken with the removal and displacement of fill and the referenced tree(s), native grasses, forbs and ferns per the LSAA.

Crossing #2: Replaced the undersized 24” diameter culvert with a 48” diameter culvert, with the length extending past the fill prism of the road. This was undertaken with the removal and displacement of fill and the referenced tree(s), native grasses, forbs and ferns per the LSAA.

Crossing #3: Replaced the undersized 12” diameter culvert with an 18” diameter overflow culvert to ensure 2-feet of free board.

Crossing #4: Decommissioned the dirt ford crossing and restored the stream channel per the LSAA.

Crossing #5: Replaced the undersized 8” diameter culvert with a 36” diameter culvert with the length extending past the fill prism of the road. This was done with the watercourse remaining in the current flow path with the removal and displacement of fill, rock, and the referenced tree(s), native grasses, forbs and ferns per the LSAA.

Crossing #6: Replaced the dirt ford crossing with a 24-inch culvert

Erosion control was undertaken in all necessary locations. The work was completed by Galen Wilson/SCG Services of Humboldt County, in accordance with our LSAA. Prior to partaking in the work, Galen Wilson/SCG Services reviewed our LSAA and all applicable requirements.
