RESOLUTION NAMING THE ADERPOINT BRIDGE IN MEMORY OF TREVOR JOHN EARLEY

WHEREAS, Trevor Earley, 25, a beloved son, brother, grandson, devoted friend and cherished member of a fourth-generation Native Alderpoint family, was tragically murdered on Jan. 6, 2022; and

WHEREAS, born on Dec. 11, 1996, Trevor spent all of his early years in Southern Humboldt, where he developed a love for the Eel River, hunting, fishing and sports. Among his many athletic accomplishments, his undefeated wrestling career stands out as a testament to his determination and skill; and

WHEREAS, in 7th grade, Trevor moved schools to Ferndale, where he became an integral part of the Ferndale School District community excelling in football and basketball and made history as the first freshman to play on the varsity football team; and

WHEREAS, while he made lifelong friends and countless memories in Ferndale, Alderpoint has always remained his home; and

WHEREAS, after graduating in 2015, Trevor decided to reside in his hometown of Alderpoint, where he could often be found surrounded by family and friends, embracing his love for the outdoors through hunting and fishing; and

WHEREAS, Trevor was a gentle soul with a big heart, known for championing the underdog and fiercely loving those around him; and

WHEREAS, his vibrant energy and unwavering kindness left an indelible mark on everyone he met; and

WHEREAS, Trevor's loss is deeply felt, and his absence is a profound reminder of his impact on the lives of those who knew and loved him; and

WHEREAS, the Alderpoint Bridge holds a special significance for the community and has become a gathering place for family, friends and loved ones to celebrate Trevor's life and share cherished memories; and

WHEREAS, the bridge, affectionately known as the Trevor John Earley Bridge, stands as a heartfelt tribute to a young man who touched countless lives with his compassion, strength and unwavering spirit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

1. Recognizes that Trevor Earley will be forever cherished and remembered by his community at this local landmark, consistent with the criteria listed in Resolution 95-92 for the naming of county bridges, roads, parks, and geographic features; and
2. Establishes the name of the Alderpoint Bridge as the Trevor John Earley Memorial Bridge.
