WHEREAS, on August 29, 2004, Jamie Barney was promoted to the rank of Deputy Sheriff Recruit; and

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2005, Jamie Barney was promoted to the rank of Deputy Sheriff I after successfully completing the College of the Redwoods 96th Basic Law Enforcement Academy; and

WHEREAS, on December 31, 2006, Jamie Barney was promoted to the rank of Deputy Sheriff II; and

WHEREAS, on October 21, 2018, Jamie Barney was promoted to the rank of Sheriff's Sergeant; and

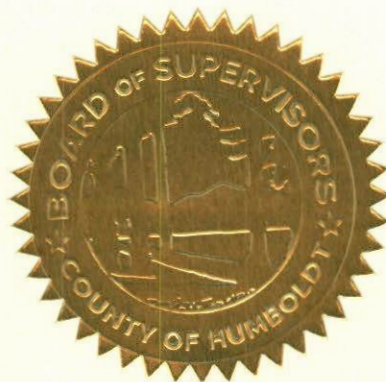
