



AGREEMENT TO GRANT TERMS

By depositing the grant check, your organization agrees to the following terms and conditions set forth by the Humboldt Area Foundation and Wild Rivers Community Foundation (the Foundation):

• Grant funds must be used for the charitable purpose(s) outlined in the grant packet. The Foundation's grants are to be used exclusively for purposes that are charitable, educational, religious, scientific, literary; testing for public safety; and the prevention of cruelty to children or animals.

• Grants will not support expenditures against public policy, for unrelated business activities or in another way that violates requirements of Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3).

• Grant funds are prohibited from supporting organizations and activities that incite or engage in violence, intimidation, harassment, threats, or defamation targeting an individual or group based on their actual or perceived race, color, religion, national origin, ethnicity, immigration status, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, or disability, or supporting organizations and activities that are contrary to the Foundation's mission and its charitable purpose.

• Your organization retains full discretion and control over the selection of any sub-grantees or individuals to carry out the work set forth in your proposal. In doing so, your organization will act completely independently of the Foundation.

• Your organization agrees to contact a Program Officer, Program Manager, or Director of the Foundation if there are significant changes to program staff, timeline, or status during the grant period.

• Your organization understands and agrees that reporting must be submitted to the Foundation as outlined in the grant packet. Failure to do so may affect your organization's eligibility to apply for the Foundation's grants in the future.

• The total amount of this grant or any payment thereof may be discontinued, modified, or withheld at any time if, in the judgment of the Foundation, such (i) is warranted because grant funds are not being used as required by this agreement or (ii) is necessary to comply with the requirements of the law, regulations, or rulings.

• This grant is not earmarked for any attempt to influence legislation. Thus, any use of grant funds by your organization for such activities constitutes a decision of your organization that is wholly independent of the Foundation.
