CHAPTER 4

HUMBOLDT COUNTY FISH AND GAME ADVISORY COMMITTEE

224-1. ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMITTEE.

The Fish and Game Advisory Committee of the County of Humboldt is hereby established. (Ord. 682 § 1, 7/8/69)

224-2. APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF COMMITTEE.

The Committee shall consist of fifteen (15) members. The Supervisor of each district shall appoint three (3) members. The three (3) members appointed by the individual Supervisors of Districts 1, 2 and 3 shall serve a term which shall become effective on the date the member is appointed and shall expire on June 30, 1986. The three (3) members appointed by the individual Supervisors of Districts 4 and 5 shall serve a term which shall become effective on the date the member is appointed and shall expire on June 30, 1987. All subsequent appointments to fill vacancies which result from the expiration of a term of office shall be for a term of four (4) years from and after the expiration of the term of the office to which the appointment is being made. Persons appointed to fill a vacancy which results from an event other than expiration of a term of office shall serve until expiration of the term of the office to which the appointment is made. Members of the Committee shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors. (Ord. 1660 § 1, 10/30/84; amended by Ord. 1665 \$ 1, 12/18/84)

224-3. PURPOSE OF COMMITTEE.

The Committee is established to serve in an advisory capacity to the Board of Supervisors in all matters concerning fish and game within the County of Humboldt. (Ord. 682 \$ 3, 7/8/69)

224-4. MEETINGS.

The Committee shall hold regular monthly meetings at such time and place as shall be agreed upon by the Committee and such other special meetings as shall be required from time to time. Special meetings may be called by the Chairman of the Committee or, in his absence, by the Vice Chairman of the Committee. (Ord. 682 § 4, 7/8/69)
