

AGREEMENT FOR
HUMBOLDT COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT
LOCAL MUTUAL AID
2025

BACKGROUND:

1. The County, Cities, and State maintain and operate Law Enforcement (police) agencies within the Humboldt Operational Area (Humboldt County): and
2. It is the intention of the parties to this agreement to voluntarily aid and support each other when such aid is necessary and requested by one of the parties as herein specified: and
3. The parties to this agreement desire to execute it in accordance with the law and established procedures.

THE PARTIES HERETO MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:


1. To provide police protection personnel and necessary equipment and to render such services to assist each other as needed in dealing with a situation, which at the given time, is beyond the control of either of the parties hereto acting without the other's assistance, and which therefore likely requires mutual help.
2. Such mutual aid shall be provided within the County of Humboldt; however, neither party shall be required to reduce its own protection resources, personnel, services, and facilities to the detriment of its normal protection capability.
3. The parties hereto will not respond to a mutual aid request made under this agreement unless such a request is received through the established communication channels common to each party and is made by a responsible law enforcement official of the requesting agency.
4. Any mutual aid provided under this agreement will be given with the clear understanding that the local law enforcement official responsible in the requesting jurisdiction shall remain in charge of the incident, including the coordination of personnel and equipment supplied through this mutual aid agreement.
5. That the integrity of responding forces and the policies and procedures of their departments will be upheld. Exceptions will require approval from the respective department.
6. Except as provided by a separate agreement between the parties, the mutual aid assurance outlined here shall be the sole consideration for this performance. Neither party is

obligated to reimburse the other for any action taken or aid rendered, or for any use of material, damage to equipment, or liability incurred during the assistance provided.




