**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ARCATA
RECOMMENDING HUMBOLDT COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS
ADOPTION OF THE REGIONAL HOUSING NEEDS ALLOCATION METHOD**

WHEREAS, State Housing Element law requires periodic Housing Element updates; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Housing Needs Allocation provides crucial data for the Regional Housing Needs Plan and the City of Arcata's 2027-2035 Housing Element update; and

WHEREAS, Humboldt County Association of Governments Board's preferred Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA) methodology for Humboldt County has been reviewed by the City Council of the City of Arcata; and

WHEREAS, the proposed RHNA methodology results in an allocation that reflects a thoughtful, planned strategy for growth that considers the relationship between housing and jobs, the impact of growth on existing communities, and the effect of growth on the environment for each jurisdiction in the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Arcata supports the proposed RHNA methodology that allocates housing responsibility based on 50% projected population growth, and on 50% existing employment.
