NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY (NOFA) 2024 PERMANENT LOCAL HOUSING ALLOCATION (PLHA) PROGRAM NON-ENTITLEMENT LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMPETITIVE

Notice is hereby given that the City of Eureka intends to submit an application to the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) for funding under the 2024 Permanent Local Housing Allocation (PLHA) Program – Non-Entitlement Local Government Competitive funding cycle.

The PLHA Program is authorized pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 50470 et seq. and is funded through the Building Homes and Jobs Trust Fund. The purpose of the program is to assist local governments in meeting their housing needs by supporting activities that increase the supply of housing, preserve existing affordable housing, and address homelessness, consistent with local housing planning documents and state housing priorities.

Eligible activities under the PLHA Program may include, but are not limited to, affordable housing development, rehabilitation or preservation of housing, rental assistance, housing-related infrastructure, homelessness prevention and intervention programs, and other eligible activities as defined in HCD's PLHA Program Guidelines.

PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT

The City of Eureka's proposed PLHA application and intended use of funds will be available for public review prior to submission to HCD. Members of the public are invited to review the proposed application and provide comments regarding the City's proposed use of PLHA funds.
