- 3. Adopt a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Eureka adopting water rates and impact fees for the City of Eureka; and
- 4. Adopt a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Eureka adopting sanitary sewer rates and impact fees for the City of Eureka

#### DISCUSSION

The City has contracted with NBS to conduct a review of the City's water and sewer rates and propose updated rate schedules for FY23-FY27. NBS has analyzed the information provided by the City and has provided a draft final report (attached). The report provides details on the rate setting process, revenue and expense projections and proposed rates and impact fees for water and sewer.

Notices have been mailed to all ratepayers and property owners within the city in conformance with Proposition 218. Protests are required from 50% +1 of all parcels in the City (roughly 4800 protests) in order to stop the adoption of proposed rates. As of 12/12/22, the City has received a total of 167 written protests. Additional protests may

be submitted at the public hearing, so the final count is unknown, but is unlikely to reach the threshold required to halt the proceedings.

The City's rate consultant will give a presentation outlining their methodology, findings and recommendations including proposed rate/fee schedules.
