**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ARCATA
DESIGNATING THE NEPA CERTIFYING OFFICER FOR THREE APPLICATIONS
FOR FUNDING UNDER THE STATE 2025 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK
GRANT PROGRAM (25-CDBG)**

WHEREAS, the City approved three applications for funding under the State 2025 Community Development Block Grant Program (25-CDBG) by duly noticed Resolution 256-40 on March 18, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearings on February 4, 2026, February 17, 2026, February 18, 2026 and February 27, 2026 to receive ideas and suggestions on potential projects for CDBG Program funding; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is relying on staff review of the citizen participation plan for compliance with federal statutes and determined that this plan was followed for the development of the 25-CDBG applications; and

WHEREAS, the City must designate a National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) certifying officer to make determinations regarding the environmental impacts associated with Federally funded programs and projects;

1. The Community Development Director is the National Environmental Policy Act Certifying Officer.
