DISCUSSION

The City owns a marine fueling facility at the foot of Commercial Street that is the primary fueling location on Humboldt Bay. The fueling facility historically consisting of four (4) single-walled underground storage tanks (USTs).

On March 11, 2025 the City received a notice from the Humboldt County Department of Health and Human Services' Environmental Health Division. In summary, the letter stated that single-walled storage tanks will no longer be compliant with state law as of December 31st, 2025, and that the single-walled tanks need to be removed by that date.

On August 5, 2025, Council authorized The Commercial Street Fueling Facility – Tank Replacement Project, which included purchase of a new aboveground fuel tank and authority to enter into contracts for installation of the new tank as well as removal of the existing USTs with an additional appropriation of \$1,000,000.

The City phased the project starting with purchase and installation of a new tank and a second phase to remove and dispose of the existing USTs.

The City requested quotes from four qualified contractors for the UST Removal Project. Three declined to bid. Mercer Fraser Co submitted a bid in conformance with project requirements in the amount of \$416,814.00

During the course of the project, two change orders were executed for a final project cost of \$436,599.10.

Staff has determined that the work specified in the contract has been completed in substantial conformance with the plans and specifications. Therefore, staff recommends that Council accept the Commercial Street Fueling Facility UST Removal Project, Bid No. 2025-13, and authorize staff to file a notice of completion for the project.
