

**POST-ADOPTION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE**

December 20, 2022, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_\_, which amends Section 311-7 of the Humboldt County Zoning Code to reclassify lands currently zoned Unclassified and Agriculture Exclusive within the proposed Hunter Ranch Agriculture Preserve to Agriculture Exclusive with a Special Building Site combining zone specifying a minimum lot size of 160 acres (AE B-5(160)).
