### **RECOMMENDATION**

Waive reading, read by title only and introduce Bill No. #1025-CS., an Ordinance of the City Council, repealed in its entirety and replaced with Chapter 51- Solid Waste, Sections 51.01-51.33.

### **DISCUSSION**

SB1383- California's Short Lived Climate Pollutant bill aims to reduce methane emissions from the landfill and rescue 20% of edible food statewide.

This new state mandate requires that cities adopt an enforceable ordinance to implement SB1383 requirements locally. Due to overlap with the existing Chapter 51 Solid Waste, the chapter is repealed in its entirety and replaced.

Along with carrying over existing Chapter 51 sections, the new additions to Chapter 51 include new requirements for the universal collection (single family, multi-family, and commercial) of trash, recycling, and compost in addition to requirements by the franchise hauler such as contamination monitoring, bin colors and labels, and route reviews.

The ordinance includes new requirements for certain "Commercial Edible Food Generators" which will need to arrange to donate all excess edible food and associated reporting requirements by the generator and the food rescue organizations.

Lastly, the ordinance requires procurement targets for the City to accomplish to utilize materials from recovered organic waste products locally, and to utilize recycled paper products.
