Hi Shannon,

I took some time to consult with my supervising planner Cliff Johnson and the planning team about canines for these two Lost Creek Farms, LLC projects. Since the application materials, including Operations Plan and subsequent Security Plan, do not include any mention of dogs used in conjunction with the cannabis project we do not have a method to restrict the presence of canines in relation to the cannabis application.

Our intent is to disclose in the staff report we received comments from CA State Parks regarding concerns about loose canines and potential for harassment of wildlife and sensitive receptors, but we have limited capacity to restrict their presence onsite since there is not a clear nexus to the cannabis operation. The Planning Commission may decide to require a condition limiting presence of canines based on the concerns we received, but staff do not have a clear path to simply add a project condition to prohibit canines onsite.

Are you all still compiling a response for us to review and incorporate into the staff report? Today is

the general deadline we set and was just wondering what the disposition of the response might be. I appreciate your time and consideration.

Pleasure to make your virtual acquaintance. The Security section of the Operations Plan is brief and includes only an indication of a locked gate and security cameras, it is located at the end of the first attachment labeled "10820 Operations Plan." I will consult with my supervising planner Cliff Johnson to see if we are able to condition the project to include any limitations for canines.

Yes, keep me apprised of any comments by May 3, 2023. This should allow us time to incorporate any concerns into the project and conditions of approval, if necessary. We previously included Conditions of Approval disallowing generators or lights until the applicant provides a plan for addressing noise and light, approved by our Planning Division staff, prior to use of lights or generators if/when the project gains final local approval. This was done to address the proximity to NSO habitat and other sensitive receptors nearby.
