As you are aware, Code Enforcement has an open case on your property located at 4092 Excelsior Road, Eureka, California 95503, APN: 018-142-006.

At your request a Code Enforcement Appeal Hearing and an Administrative Civil Penalty Appeal Hearing were held on September 9, 2022, to contest the Notice to Abate Nuisance and Notice of Violation and Proposed Administrative Civil Penalty issued against your property.

On November 14, 2022, you were served with the Finding of Nuisance and Order of Abatement and Finding of Violation and Order Imposing Administrative Civil Penalty issued by the Hearing Officer. These findings imposed an Administrative Civil Penalty in the amount of \$1,250 and allowed for 20 days to complete the corrective actions listed.

On January 24, 2023, a drive- by was conducted of the property and found the property to be out of compliance with the Findings issued by the Hearing Officer.
