## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The River Lodge and Monday Club held a total of 27 events in the month of May.
At the beginning of the month, Fortuna Chamber of Commerce held their annual dinner at River Lodge. "Under the Big Top" was the theme. The table decorations were incredible. Guests really seemed to enjoy themselves.

The Tang Soo Do Region 1, hosted a dinner following a Martial Arts competition. This event brought in many people from out of town to our friendly city.

CalFire returned for a two-day training and the Fortuna Police Department held their department meeting.

The Annual Dairy Princess Pageant was held this month. There were two candidates. Attendance was down a bit, but otherwise the event was a success.

A large retirement dinner was held for the Redway Volunteer Fire Department Chief. The group stayed well into the evening and enjoyed a bonfire on the patio.
