RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Council conduct a public hearing to receive input regarding unmet transit needs, and direct staff to forward all comments to the Humboldt County Association of Governments (HCAOG).

INTRODUCTION:

Annually, the Humboldt County Association of Governments (HCAOG) reviews unmet transit needs through a multi-jurisdictional public hearing process throughout Humboldt County. As part of this annual process, HCAOG encourages member entities to conduct separate public hearings to receive local comments. DISCUSSION:

Comments generated during the public hearing process are to be submitted to HCAOG for inclusion in the annual Unmet Transit Needs Report of Findings. Public input will then be put into one of three categories:

- A. That there are no unmet transit needs; or
- B. That there are no unmet transit needs which are reasonable to meet; or
- C. That there are unmet transit needs, including those that are reasonable to meet.

The adoption of the final HCAOG Report of Findings will occur in early 2024. Please refer to attachments for more detailed information.

No immediate financial impact. Funding for any additional service recommendations or unmet needs would be paid from fares, other transit subsidies, and revenues.
