DISCUSSION

The Eureka Police Department received \$28,000 through The Officer Wellness and Mental Health Grant Program, established in the 2022 Budget Act (Assembly Bill 178, Chapter 45, Statutes of 2022). The allocation of funds for each eligible agency was determined based on the number of peace officers described in Penal Code section 830.1 that are employed. These funds will be used for comprehensive on-site health and fitness assessment, continued personalized consultations for obtaining information on diet, lifestyle, behavior and exercise habits, expanding the department's peer support team, and utilizing services provided by a licensed mental health clinician that works with law enforcement.
