To whom it may concern

I would like to point out that the Imperiale building on the alley side has the same Windows we have purchased and are proposing to install. Robert Imperiale was the original signer with the historical society. The windows that are there have not failed and after discussion with Milguard the manufacturer and Smitbaurh the local supplier they stated rarely if ever has the Tuscany series windows failed and that if they do they are warranted.

I have not found one local contractor willing to give a written quote on window repair of the old windows. They did say it would be several weeks to repair each one and during which time the opening would need boarded. One contractor gave me a verbal estimate of \$1200 to \$2000 per unit . We cannot afford this cost .
