 3 On 8-21-17, at approximately 1455 hours, I was on duty when I responded to the Blue Herron
 4 (located at 2245 Broadway) for a report of a structure fire. It was reported that there were subjects
 5 on scene and two females were possibly seen fleeing from the location. One female was reported
 6 to possibly have a firearm.
 7
 8 I knew that the Blue Herron was owned by Floyd Squires and was currently in receivership.
 9
 10 I arrived on scene and contacted Deputy Fire Chief Bill Reynolds. Multiple fire engines were on
 11 scene and were actively fighting a fire at the Blue Herron. Specifically, I observed the northern two-
 12 story office building was on fire. Sgt. Wilson, FTO Hill, Officer Couch, and Det. Rabang were on
 13 scene. Additional fire and Eureka Police volunteers were on scene providing traffic control. Deputy
 14 Chief Reynolds told me the fire was most likely caused by human action.
 15
 16 A nearby male subject who was loitering behind a large advertising sign just north of the scene told
 17 me he had seen two females head towards the [REDACTED]. The male
 18 refused to identify himself or provide further information.
 19
 20 I went to the [REDACTED] and contacted [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. They stated they saw
 21 two females shortly after noticing the Blue Herron was on fire.
 22
 23 The following is a summary of [REDACTED] statement: [REDACTED] was near the front of the [REDACTED] when
 24 she noticed smoke coming from the Blue Herron. [REDACTED] saw two females who appeared to be
 25 running from the Blue Herron towards the [REDACTED] along the eastern sidewalk of Broadway.
 26 [REDACTED] described both females as heavysset white female adults. [REDACTED] saw one of the females
 27 appear to get into an argument with a passing vehicle, which she described as a [REDACTED]
 28 [REDACTED]. The vehicle was headed northbound on Broadway. [REDACTED] saw a male subject
 29 in the front passenger seat of the vehicle. [REDACTED] saw one of the females strike at and throw some
 30 shoes at the vehicle. The females then continued on their way towards the [REDACTED] and the
 31 [REDACTED] pulled into the parking lot of the nearby Aaron's appliance store. [REDACTED] did not follow or
 32 continue to watch the females [REDACTED] mentioned the shoes the female threw were still in the

 34 several dozen yards south of the [REDACTED]

 36 The following is a summary of [REDACTED] statement: [REDACTED] was also near the front of the [REDACTED]
 37 [REDACTED] during the incident. [REDACTED] saw two female subjects come onto [REDACTED] property and
 38 begin to go upstairs. [REDACTED] confronted the females, stating they needed to sign in. One of the
 39 females told [REDACTED] that they had already signed in earlier that day. [REDACTED] told them they
 40 needed to sign in again. The female said she had to go and left without signing in. [REDACTED] saw the
 41 females enter room [REDACTED]

42
 43 [REDACTED] said she had seen the females earlier in the day and that they had also earlier signed in to
 44 see a resident. [REDACTED] showed me the sign in logs, which showed the females signed in as
 45 "Desrey + Katie". The entry was not timed, however the entry before read 0830 hours and the entry
 46 after read 1156 hours. [REDACTED]

47
 48 [REDACTED] said room [REDACTED] was registered to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] said she believed the females
 49 were still inside the room. [REDACTED] said she had knocked on the door however there was no
 50 response.

51
 52 Sgt. Wilson, FTO Hill, and Officer Couch had cleared the scene to handle other calls for service
 53 within the city. Det. Rabang was still on scene. Due to the report of the firearm, I left the [REDACTED]
 54 [REDACTED] to retrieve Det. Rabang in order to safely contact room [REDACTED]. I found Det. Rabang near the
 55 Blue Herron. We were walking back towards the [REDACTED] when I saw two female subjects
 56 standing on the eastern sidewalk of Broadway just south of the [REDACTED]. Both females
 57 appeared to be heavysset white female adults with blonde hair, which matched the description [REDACTED]
 58 had earlier provided. I immediately recognized one of the females as Kattie Yocum from prior
 59 contacts. Yocum approached the pair of red and black shoes in the shoulder of the roadway,
 60 retrieved them, and put them on her feet. Det. Raband and I contacted Yocum and the other
 61 female, who verbally identified herself as Desiree Henley.

62
 63 I asked Yocum if she knew anything about the nearby structure fire. The following is a summary of
 64 Yocum's statement: Just prior to the fire Yocum was just north of the Blue Herron. Yocum admitted
 65 she was standing between 2169 Broadway and 2235 Broadway urinating in the small gap between
 66 the two buildings. Yocum denied being inside the Blue Heron or having any involvement in the fire.

67
 68 Yocum said she had been inside room [REDACTED] and the room's resident [REDACTED] was her
 69 boyfriend.

70
 71 I then spoke to Henley. Henley admitted she and Yocum had been inside the Blue Herron. Henley
 72 said they entered via a doorway which had unsecured plywood covering it (on the south side of the
 73 building). Henley said Yocum told her she was angry at the building's owner, Floyd Squires. Henley

74 said Yocum told her that she (Yocum) had performed oral sex on Squires at an earlier unspecified
75 time. Henley said Yocum told her Squires had offered her (Yocum) an apartment residence in
76 exchange for the sex act. Henley said Yocum told her she (Yocum) performed the sex act on
77 Squires, however Squires had not provided the apartment. Henley said Yocum told her she was
78 setting fire to the building as revenge against Squires. Henley said she witnessed as Yocum used
79 a small handheld lighter to set fire to some piles of various paper which were strewn about the first
80 room on the first floor of the building. Henley said she was willing to speak about what she
81 witnessed because Yocum set fire to the building despite Henley repeatedly telling her not to.

82
83 Henley mentioned there was another female subject who was inside the building at the time Yocum
84 set fire to it. Henley said she yelled at the other female to get out of the building. Henley said she
85 and Yocum fled the building before the unknown third female did; she did not see if the other
86 female successfully exited the building. Henley described the third female to Det. Rabang. Det.
87 Rabang later told me he believed the other female was [REDACTED]; Det. Rabang said he had
88 previously contacted [REDACTED] inside the Blue Herron.

89
90 Henley said she and Yocum were running northbound when they saw a passerby in a vehicle
91 taking pictures of them as they ran. Henley said Yocum confronted the vehicle and threw her shoes
92 at it. Henley said they continued to the [REDACTED] and went to room [REDACTED], which belonged to
93 Yocum's boyfriend. They came out some time later and were contacted.

94
95 Based on Yocum's admission that she was near the Blue Herron at the time of the incident,
96 Henley's statement that Yocum had started the fire, and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] statement where
97 they stated they witnessed Yocum fleeing the scene, I believed I had probable cause to arrest
98 Yocum for arson. I detained Yocum in handcuffs. I provided Yocum with a Miranda admonishment,
99 which she appeared to have trouble understanding. Ultimately, I allowed Yocum to read my
100 department issued Miranda card, which she said she understood. Yocum said she understood her
101 rights and wanted to talk about what happened. However, when confronted with [REDACTED], [REDACTED],
102 and Henley's statements against her, Yocum requested an attorney. A records check on Yocum
103 revealed she was on summary probation. I concluded the interview with Yocum and arrested her
104 for arson and probation violation.

105
106 I secured Yocum in the rear of my patrol unit. I searched Yocum and her property incident to arrest,
107 specifically looking for the handheld lighter Henley mentioned. I did not locate a lighter in Yocum's
108 property. I suspected Yocum had either disposed of the lighter or concealed it within room [REDACTED]

109
110 I transported Yocum to the Humboldt County Correctional Facility (HCCF), where she was booked
111 for 451(c) PC and 1203.2(a) PC. Yocum had a small skateboard with her which I later booked into
112 EPD property for safekeeping.

114 I later returned to the Blue Herron and took several photographs of the building (see attached). The
 115 fire damage appeared to be mainly concentrated on a first floor room at the southeast area of the
 116 building. I knew from prior experience the door used to have a piece of plywood over it which was
 117 often removed by transient trespassers. It appeared consistent with Henley's statement.
 118

119 Later in the shift I received a message from [REDACTED] who reported she had witnessed the
 120 incident. On 8-22-17 I called [REDACTED] and her husband, [REDACTED] and asked them what they
 121 witnessed. The following is a summary of their statement: On 8-21-17, just prior to the incident, [REDACTED]
 122 was driving her [REDACTED] with her husband [REDACTED] sitting in the front passenger
 123 seat. They had just left Adell's Restaurant and were headed southbound on Broadway when they
 124 saw smoke coming from the Blue Herron [REDACTED] being a retired firefighter, was concerned about the
 125 smoke. He saw the smoke change color, which to him indicated a worsening fire [REDACTED] conducted a
 126 U-turn to head back towards the Blue Heron. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to call 911. [REDACTED] tried however got a
 127 busy signal, likely due to many other callers reporting the same fire. As they passed the Blue
 128 Herron, they saw two females (Yocum and Henley) running northbound from the Blue Herron. [REDACTED]
 129 described the two females as "jubilant, giddy, and laughing". [REDACTED] said it "didn't look like they were
 130 running for their lives from a fire". Based on their behavior [REDACTED] suspected the females had started
 131 the fire. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to take pictures of the females as they drove by. [REDACTED] took a picture of the
 132 females, however they were confronted by a female with long hair (who I believed was Henley, as
 133 Yocum had a shaved head). Henley yelled at them, "You can't be taking pictures!" The females ran
 134 up to their vehicle and threw items at the vehicle, including a pair of shoes. [REDACTED] then drove off and
 135 parked in the parking lot of the nearby Aaron's appliance store (located at 2029 Broadway). [REDACTED]
 136 called 911 and was able to speak to a dispatcher. She reported she had taken pictures of the
 137 suspects. [REDACTED] later responded to the front counter of EPD and provided a digital copy of the
 138 photograph her husband took and her contact information to the front office staff, who later
 139 provided the photograph and information to me (see attached).
 140

141 I later viewed the photograph, which clearly showed Henley and Yocum. In the photograph Yocum
 142 appeared to be running northbound on the east sidewalk of Broadway away from the Blue Heron.
 143 Henley is on the shoulder of the roadway and appears to have her right arm cocked back, as if she
 144 was about to throw something at the photographer. White colored smoke can be seen in the
 145 background coming from the Blue Herron.
 146

147 Additionally, the photograph showed Yocum appeared to be wearing all dark clothing; a black shirt
 148 and black pants. I recalled that when I arrested Yocum on scene, she had been wearing a red
 149 jacket and blue shorts. I believed Yocum had changed her clothing while she was in room [REDACTED] of
 150 the [REDACTED]. I suspected the clothing she wore while inside the Blue Herron had become soiled
 151 with residue from the fire she set.

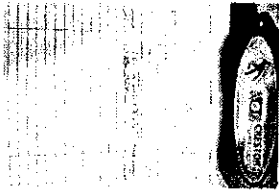

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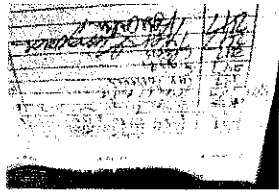
153 I later booked digital copies of the photographs I took of the building and the photographs I took of

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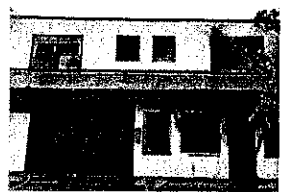
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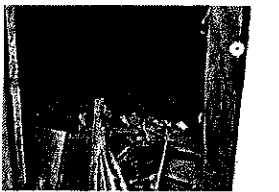
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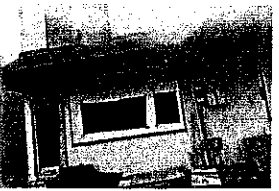
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
