POTENTIAL PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS**

Community Development

Acquisition and/or improvement of housing facilities for persons experiencing homelessness:

1. **Project:** Arcata House Partnership Boyd Road water and sewer connection
Program Proponent: Arcata House Partnership (AHP)
NEPA Environmental Review Level: Environmental Assessment
Estimated Cost: \$147,657
Description: Connect the AHP shelter on Boyd Rd. to city sewer and water to increase capacity and allow for additional separation of occupants per COVID-19 recommendations.

Public Services to respond to COVID-19 impacts:

1. **Program:** Mobile Intervention and Services Team (MIST) program funding
Program Proponent: Arcata Police Department (APD) and Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS)
NEPA Environmental Review Level: Categorically Excluded Subject to Section 58.5
Estimated Cost: Up to the maximum funding available dependent upon need and council prioritization
Description: Provide funding for DHHS staff to continue providing outreach to individuals experiencing homelessness in Arcata with APD Community Response Unit officers in order to reduce the number of individuals experiencing homelessness with the goal of preventing the exposure and spread of COVID-19 within the homeless population.
2. **Program:** Short-term rental assistance program
Project Proponent: City of Arcata
NEPA Environmental Review Level: Categorically Excluded Subject to Section 58.5
Estimated Cost: Up to the maximum funding available dependent upon need and council prioritization
Description: Provide short-term rental assistance to Arcata residents who have experienced a reduction in income due to COVID-19.
3. **Program:** Childcare vouchers for income eligible residents
Project Proponent: City of Arcata
NEPA Environmental Review Level: Categorically Excluded Subject to Section 58.5
Estimated Cost: Up to the maximum funding available dependent upon need and council prioritization
Description: Provide funding for childcare, after-school, or school break camps to assist low-to-moderate income families who have been impacted by COVID-19 obtain childcare.
4. **Program:** Provide Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and signage or marketing for businesses that are reopening

Project Proponent: City of Arcata

NEPA Environmental Review Level: Categorically Excluded Subject to Section 58.5

Estimated Cost: Up to the maximum funding available dependent upon need and council prioritization

Description: Obtain Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and signage or marketing for businesses that are reopening.

5. **Program:** Assist non-profits with funding for food

Project Proponent: City of Arcata

NEPA Environmental Review Level: Categorically Excluded Subject to Section 58.5

Estimated Cost: Up to the maximum funding available dependent upon need and council prioritization

Description: Provide assistance to local non-profit organizations who provide food to the community and have experienced an increase in the need for services due to the impacts of COVID-19 on the local economy.

6. **Program:** Provide assistance to local families struggling with distance learning

Project Proponent: Black Humboldt

NEPA Environmental Review Level: Categorically Excluded Subject to Section 58.5

Estimated Cost: Up to the maximum funding available dependent upon need and council prioritization

Description: Provide families with internet access and necessary devices (iPads, laptops, printers) to assist with distance learning.
