Supplemental interviews:

I contacted several associates of Rory who were present during the incident on the lake. The following are a summary of their statements.

Luke Brownfield stated he organized the camping trip with several other families and work associates. While out on the lake with around twenty other individuals, including juveniles, Rory and Stephanie went kayaking by themselves. Rory was dressed in cargo pants and a long sleeve shirt. As Rory returned from kayaking and was getting onto the boat, via swim-step, the Judge pushed him into the water.

Luke stated Rory laughed and someone else immediately pushed the Judge in the water. Everyone was laughing and pushing each other in the water. Luke stated he never heard the Judge make a derogatory comment towards Rory and in no way was Rory singled out by the Judge.

Quincy Brownfield, Luke's wife, had similar statements and stated Rory seemed normal after the incident and throughout the remainder of the camping trip. Quincy did not hear the Judge make any comments towards Rory and believes it never occurred.

Kennessey Mets stated she did not actually observe the Judge push Rory into the water, but as everyone on the boat was engaging, in the same, having fun, she did not believe it was malicious in any way. Mets never heard the Judge say anything inappropriate or derogatory towards Rory.

Casey Russo stated he was in the water when Rory returned from kayaking with Stephanie. As Rory was getting onto the boat, the Judge pushed Rory into the water. Rory caught himself and only fell into the water up to his waist. Casey said Rory was laughing afterwards and everyone was having a good time. Casey stated Rory interacted happily with the group while out on the lake and no issue was noted between Rory and the Judge.

Casey stated at no time did the Judge ever make rude, inappropriate or lewd comments to Rory or anyone else during the camping trip.

Based on witness statements, I do not believe the act was intentional or malicious. This report will be informational only and not forwarded to the Shasta County District Attorney's Office.
