WHEN TO CALL 911

Call 911 in an emergency situation that requires **immediate** assistance from the police, fire department, or an ambulance, such as:

- Fire
- · Medical Emergencies
- Missing Child
- Burglary or theft in progress
- · Car that has just been stolen
- · Gunfire plus screams or yelling
- Yourself or someone else being assaulted
- Car accident with life threatening injuries

When Reporting a Crime:

The questions asked by the Dispatcher depend on the situation. Try to remain calm and patient. The Dispatcher may be responding to multiple calls. Specify if you want an officer to contact you directly. When calling for police assistance or to report a crime, try to provide the following information to the Dispatcher:

- Your name and the address from where you are calling
 Calls made on a cell phone will be answered by CHP, who can forward
 your call to the appropriate emergency response agency.
- What you are reporting
- · Description of the person(s) involved:

Sex Hair Color & Length
Race Facial Hair / Glasses
Age Clothing Description

Height & Weight Any Special Marks or Features

- If the person is no longer at the scene, tell the dispatcher if he/ she left on foot or in a vehicle. Try to provide vehicle description and direction of travel
- · Stay on the line until the Dispatcher instructs you to hang up

WHEN TO CALL (707) 822-2424 ARCATA POLICE NON-EMERGENCY DISPATCHER

Call the 24-hour non-emergency Arcata Police Dispatcher to request police response in a situation that is **not an emergency** but needs attention, such as:

- Assault after the act
- Suspected child or elder neglect or abuse
- Home or vehicle burglary, break-in or theft after the act
- Apparent drug deal or illicit activity
- · Suspicious person in neighborhood
- Vandalism or graffiti
- Illegal camping on private property
- Aggressive panhandling
- Loud parties or disruptive behavior
- · Suspected animal abuse
- Fraud—identity theft, phone scam, mail theft

DO NOT CALL 911:

- for information
- when the power is out
- to report a broken fire hydrant
- when your water pipes burst
- to get a ride to a doctor's appointment
- for paying tickets
- for your pet
- as a prank
