3. Respondent, Kelly E. Sanders ("Elections Official"), is the Clerk, Recorder and Registrar of Voters of the County of Humboldt. In that position, she is the election official of the County of Humboldt.

- Petitioner, Tiffany Hunt Nielsen, is a candidate for the position of Clerk, 4. Recorder, and Registrar of Voters for the November 8, 2022 general election and has duly filed all documents required by the Elections Code for that purpose. Petitioner is the real party in interest in this matter pursuant to Elections Code § 13313(b)(3).
- 5. In connection with her candidacy, the Petitioner, Tiffany Hunt Nielsen, timely submitted a Candidate Statement pursuant to Elections Code § 13307. A true and correct copy of the Candidate Statement (the "Original Candidate's Statement") is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.
- 6. The Elections Official initially accepted and approved the Original Candidate's Statement and included it in in the Voter's Pamphlet prepared for public examination in accordance with Elections Code § 13313(a).
- 7. Petitioner is informed and believes, and on that basis alleges, that the public examination period commenced on Saturday, August 13, 2022 and expires on Tuesday, August 23, 2022.
- On August 16, 2022, the Elections Official informed the Petitioner in a letter that 8. an objection was made to the following phrase in the Original Candidate's Statement: "I am the only candidate with experience working in both offices." In that letter, the Elections Official indicated that she would be removing that statement from the Original Candidate's Statement prior to publication. Notably, the Elections Official failed to comply with Elections Code § 13313 which require the filing of a writ of mandate, even where the change is pursued by the Elections Official. (See Elections Code § 13313(b)(1)). A true and correct copy of this letter is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

- 9. The grounds for the Elections Official action is because the referenced sentence fails to comply with Elections Code § 13308, which requires, in relevant part, that "any candidate statement submitted must be limited to a recitation of the candidate's own personal background and qualifications, and shall not in any way make reference to other candidates for that office or to another candidate's qualifications, character, or activities. ..."
 - 10. Elections Code § 13313 provides, in full, as follows:

West's Ann.Cal.Elec.Code § 13313

§ 13313. Voter's pamphlet; public examination; writ of mandate or injunction to amend or delete materials

Currentness

- (a) The elections official shall make a copy of the material referred to in Section 13307 available for public examination in the elections official's office for a period of 10 calendar days immediately following the filling deadline for submission of those documents. Any person may obtain a copy of the candidate's statements from the elections official for use outside of the elections official's office. The elections official may charge a fee to any person obtaining a copy of the material, and the fee may not exceed the actual cost incurred by the elections official in providing the copy.
- (b)(1) During the 10-calendar-day public examination period provided by this section, any voter of the jurisdiction in which the election is being held, or the elections official, himself or herself, may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the material in the candidates statements to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or injunction request shall be filed no later than the end of the 10-calendar-day public examination period.
- (2) A peremptory writ of mandate or an injunction shall issue only upon clear and convincing proof that the material in question is false, misleading, or inconsistent with the requirements of this chapter, and that issuance of the writ or injunction will not substantially interfere with the printing or distribution of official election materials as provided by law.
- (3) The elections official shall be named as respondent and the candidate who authored the material in question shall be named as the real party in interest. In the case of the elections official bringing the mandamus or injunctive action pursuant to this subdivision, the board of supervisors of the county shall be named as the respondent and the candidate who authored the material in question shall be named as the real party in interest.

11. Elections Code § 13313 permits the Petitioner, as a voter in the County of Humboldt to seek a peremptory writ of mandate requiring the Original Candidate's Statement to be amended upon a showing of clear and convincing proof that the material in question is inconsistent with the requirements of that Chapter of the Elections Code.

- 12. The Petitioner therefore seeks a peremptory writ of mandate requiring the Original Candidate's Statement to be amended and replaced with the Candidate's Statement attached hereto as Exhibit C and incorporated herein by reference on that basis. This would replace the contested phrase, with the phrase "I have experience working in both offices." so that it complies with Elections Code § 13308.
- 13. Pursuant to Elections Code § 13314(a)(3) this matter has priority over all other civil matters.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays:

- 1. That a peremptory Writ of Mandate be issued requiring that the Candidate's Statement of Tiffany Hunt Nielsen be amended to read as set forth in Exhibit C hereto and be printed, posted, and circulated by the Elections Official in that form.
 - 2. For such other and further relief as the Court deems necessary and proper.

Tiffany:

An objection has been made to the sentence referenced below which is contained in your candidate statement for the November 8, 2022, General Election:

"I am the only candidate with experience working in both offices."

The objection was made pursuant to Election Code Section 13308 which states as follows:

"In addition to the restrictions set forth in Section 13307, any candidate's statement submitted pursuant to Section 13307 shall be limited to a recitation of the candidate's own personal background and qualifications, and shall not in any way make reference to other candidates for that office or to another candidate's qualifications, character, or activities. The elections official shall not cause to be printed, posted on an Internet Web site, or circulated any statement that the elections official determines is not so limited or that includes any reference prohibited by this section."

Based upon my review of Election Code Section 13308, I agree that the sentence in question makes reference beyond your own personal background and qualifications. Had you stated: "I have experience in both offices," there would have been no reference to another candidate. I have consulted with county counsel and they are in agreement that the sentence is not limited to a recitation of your own qualifications. Therefore, I am removing the sentence from your candidate statement prior to printing it in the voter information guide to comply with Section 13308.
