NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD

CALIFORNIA GUARANTEED INCOME PILOT PROGRAM FY 2022/23 – 2025/26

The California Department of Social Services (CDSS) is pleased to announce the proposed recipients of the California Guaranteed Income (GI) Pilot Program for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-23 through FY 2025-26, following a competitive Request for Application process. This Notice of Intent to Award should not be considered a binding commitment by CDSS to make grant awards. Grant awards become final upon execution of a grant agreement between the grantee and CDSS.

The purpose of this program is to provide grants to eligible entities to administer pilot programs that provide a guaranteed income to participants. The GI Pilot Program will provide unconditional, individual, regular cash payments intended to support the basic needs of the recipients. Funding under the GI Pilot Program will be granted to eligible entities to enable or expand pilot programs across the State and to administer and evaluate these pilots to inform future policy decisions.

The proposed grant awards are as follows:

- 1. Expecting Justice (Heluna Health DBA Public Health Foundation Enterprises, Inc.) in the amount of \$5,000,000
- 2. Inland Southern California United Way in the amount of \$5,000,000
- 3. iFoster, Inc. in the amount of \$4,763,010
- 4. Los Angeles Section National Council of Jewish Women, Inc. in the amount of \$3,681,949
- 5. San Francisco Human Services Agency in the amount of \$3,300,000
- 6. McKinleyville Community Collaborative in the amount of \$2,354,841
- 7. Ventura County Human Services Agency in the amount of \$1,500,000

Any appeals regarding the CDSS's intent to award decision must be filed within ten (10) working days after the CDSS posts this Notice of Intent to Award. Only grant applicants may appeal. Applicants wishing to appeal the award(s) must follow the Application Appeals Process referenced in the <u>Request for Application – Page 19</u>.

Grant amounts and awardees are subject to change by CDSS prior to the execution of a grant agreement.
