WHEREAS, the City of Arcata, a municipal corporation ("Public Entity"), submitted an application to the Department in response to the MORE NOFA ("Application") and in the foregoing capacity, was determined to be an eligible Public Entity under the MORE Program pursuant to that certain conditional award letter, dated December 18, 2023 ("Conditional Award Commitment").

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED, that the Public Entity is hereby authorized and directed to act on its own behalf in connection with the Program Award.

RESOLVED FURTHER: Public Entity is hereby authorized and directed to accept and incur an obligation for the Program Award. That in connection with the total amount of the Program Award, the Public Entity is authorized and directed to enter into, execute, and deliver the STD 213 Standard Agreement, and any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to secure the Program Award from the Department and to participate in the MORE Program, and all amendments thereto (collectively, "Program Award Documents").

RESOLVED FURTHER: Public Entity acknowledges and agrees that it shall be subject to the terms and conditions specified in the STD 213 Standard Agreement, and that the MORE NOFA and the Application will be incorporated by reference therein and made a part thereof. Public Entity also acknowledges and agrees that any and all activities, expenditures, information, and timelines represented and described in the Application are enforceable through the STD 213 Standard Agreement. Public Entity

also acknowledges and agrees that Program Award funds are to be expended only on the eligible uses and activities identified in the STD 213 Standard Agreement.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That the City Manager or his or her designee is hereby authorized to execute the Program Award Documents on behalf of the Public Entity.
