<del>[PROPOSED]</del> JUDGMENT ON VERIFIED PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDATE AND DEMAND FOR ATTORNEYS' FEES PURSUANT TO **CCP SECTION 1021.5** 

[CCP §1085; CRC Rule 3.1590 (f); (l)]

The above-entitled matter came on regularly for trial before the undersigned on July 26, 2023, attorney Kaitlyn Wilson appearing for Petitioners John Wilson and Cyndy Day-Wilson, attorneys Thomas Chapin and Destinee Valeska appearing for Respondents County of Humboldt (the "County") and Mario Kalson, and attorney Jeffrey Slack

appearing on behalf of Real Party in Interest Joel Geck-Moeller. The Court was presented with oral and documentary evidence, and the matter was argued by counsel and submitted for consideration by the Court.

Respondent County requested a Statement of Decision on the matters submitted. The Court issued its Tentative Ruling, Proposed Statement of Decision, and Order on October 18, 2023. Under California Rules of Court Rule 3.1590 (f), if a proposed judgment is not served within 30 days of announcement or service of a tentative decision, then any party who appeared at the trial may, within 10 days after the deadline, prepare, serve, and submit to the court a proposed statement of decision and judgment. Pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1590 (l), "if a written judgment is required, the Court must sign and file the judgment within 50 days after the announcement or service of the tentative decision." Accordingly, this proposed judgment is being prepared, served, and submitted to the Court for signing and filing by Real Party in Interest Joel Geck-Moeller.

The Court hereby adopts its Tentative Ruling, Proposed Statement of Decision, and Order, which found the following:

- 1. The plain language of Health & Safety Code §115700 does not impose a clear, present, mandatory and ministerial obligation on the County to close abandoned or permanently inactive wells.
- 2. Pursuant to Humboldt County Code §631-1, the County has discretion in deciding whether to issue permits to develop land on which an abandoned well is present, and therefore the County does not have a clear, present, and ministerial duty to destroy abandoned or permanently inactive wells and does not have a mandatory duty to condition the granting of a development permit on the destruction of an abandoned well.
- 3. Pursuant to Humboldt County Code §631-18 and California Department of Water Resources' Well Standards, Combined, Part I §3, the County has discretion in determining what action to take with respect to a landowner maintaining an abandoned well on their property, including whether to permit the use of an abandoned or inactive
